## DAY 3: MGAHINGA NATIONAL PARK

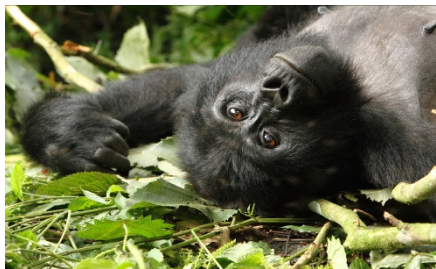

## DAY 4: MGAHINGA—BWINDI IMPENETRABLE FOREST

After an early breakfast, we will drive to Lake Mutanda where it is

a three hour canoe safari across this beautiful, island-studded lake. On the opposite shore, we will hike onwards to the edge of Bwindi Impenetrable Forest, where our luxury lodge is situated, high on Nteko ridge with panoramic views across the valley below.

## DAY 5: BWINDI IMPENETRABLE FOREST NP

Today we will enjoy an encounter with the critically endangered Mountain Gorilla. There are an estimated 800 gorillas left in the wild, with around half of them found in Bwindi. Spending up to an hour observing these magnificent animals will be unforgettable.

## DAY 6: BWINDI—LAKE MBURO NATIONAL PARK

Today we drive to Lake Mburo National Park, where we will be staying at the charming Mihingo Lodge, perched on its own rocky *kopje* overlooking the plains below. You can relax at the lodge before heading out on a night game drive around the park.

## WHAT TO PACK

A small, lightweight day backpack

Light, waterproof hiking boots or shoes

Comfortable sandals or light shoes for wearing around the lodges

Walking socks

Waterproof jacket or poncho, with hood (or waterproof hat)

Broad-brimmed sun-hat & sunglasses

Lightweight, quick-dry hiking trousers

Short-sleeved shirt or T-shirt

Long-sleeved shirts and trousers

Short-sleeved shirts, T-shirts and knee-length quick dry shorts

A down / fleece vest or safari jacket

Swim/beachwear including suitable sandals

Travel alarm clock

A sweatshirt or sweater for chilly evenings and early mornings

A camera or video-camera with high-speed settings for evening and early morning lighting conditions

Binoculars if you have them

Sunscreen (waterproof) & after-sun care

Insect repellent (tropical formula recommended)
