## Day 5 Amboseli National Park-Solio Ranch

## Day 6 Solio Ranch-Mugie Wildlife Conservancy

a game drive through the Solio Conservancy. After lunch, we will depart for Mugie Wildlife Conservancy.

## Day 7 Mugie Wildlife Conservancy

Mugie Conservancy is well known for its efforts in protecting black and white rhinos. It is also the home to some of Kenya's most famous tribesmen, including the Pokot, Turkana and Samburu. We will spend a full day in the conservancy.

## Day 8 Mugie Wildlife Conservancy-Lake Naivasha

Today, we will depart for the Great Rift Valley, stopping briefly at Thompson Falls, en-route to Mugunda Farm. On arrival at the farm, we will enjoy a tour followed by a talk on tea and coffee farming in Kenya, before continuing our journey to Lake Naivasha.
