DAY 3 & 4: SAMBURU GAME RESERVE

We will spend two full days in Samburu, enjoying game drives and looking out for several rare species; we will also meet the local people and learn about their daily lives. Alternatively, we can relax at the lodge, take a dip in the pool or enjoy a relaxing massage in the forest.

DAY 5: SAMBURU GAME RESERVE - MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

This morning, we will continue our journey on to the grand Maasai Mara. After lunch, we will enjoy an afternoon game drive, before returning to camp, which is located on a 200,000 acre private conservancy.

DAY 6 & 7: MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

We will spend two full days viewing the wildlife in the Mara, with game drives and options to enjoy hot air balloon safaris, bush walks and visits to local villages. Whatever the time of year, all visitors to the Mara are rewarded with exceptional game viewing, especially the big cats, plains game and a plethora of hippos, crocodiles and beautiful birdlife.

DAY 8: MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE - LAMU

After breakfast, we will depart the bush for the beach with a chartered flight to the ancient Swahili island of Lamu. On arrival at Manda airstrip, we will be transferred to our resort by boat.
