DAY 1: ENTEBBE

We will meet you at the airport and take you to your overnight accommodation just five minutes away, to enjoy a welcome drink.

DAY 2: ENTEBBE—KIBALE FOREST NATIONAL PARK

Today we drive to Kibale Forest NP, with lunch en route.

DAY 3: KIBALE FOREST NATIONAL PARK



Kibale Forest has the highest concentration of primates in the world. Today we will be tracking one of the most fascinating—the Chimpanzee—and spend an unforgettable hour observing them. After lunch, we visit Bigodi Wetland Sanctuary for a guided walk where we will see many birds and other monkeys.

DAY 4: KIBALE—QUEEN ELIZABETH NATIONAL PARK

This morning we drive to Mweya in QENP for lunch followed by a leisurely boat cruise, with the chance of spotting a variety of birds, as well as Hippo, Buffalo, Elephant and Crocodile.

DAY 5: QUEEN ELIZABETH NATIONAL PARK

Today we will depart for an early morning game drive, trying to spot the park's predators after their nights out hunting - Lion, Hyena and Leopard. It will also be a chance to see the large herds of Uganda Kob that populate the Kazenye Plains.

After lunch back at the lodge, we will join our local guide on the Agro-Tour - a guided walk through community land where we can learn about local farming, sample some of the produce, and witness some of the innovative solutions to human-wildlife conflicts such as the beehives used to ward Elephants off crops.

DAY 6: QUEEN ELIZABETH—BWINDI IMPENETRABLE FOREST NATIONAL PARK

Today we will travel to Bwindi via Ishasha, the southern sector of QENP. This area is known for its tree-climbing Lions and we will enjoy a game drive to try and spot them.

DAY 7: BWINDI IMPENETRABLE FOREST NP



We will spend the day tracking Mountain Gorillas—arguably the highlight of the safari. These fascinating animals are some of the rarest primates in the world, and Bwindi is one of only three places you can observe them in their natural habitat.

DAY 8: BWINDI—LAKE MBURO

We leave the Kigezi Highlands and drive to the lower lying Lake Mburo National Park, a refuge for many plains game. On the way to our lodge we will enjoy a game drive to spot Topi, Buffalo, Zebra and Impala.

DAY 9: LAKE MBURO NATIONAL PARK—ENTEBBE

After a relaxed breakfast, we leave Lake Mburo with the chance for some more game-spotting on the way. Before returning to Entebbe for your flight departure, we enjoy lunch and a classic photo opportunity at Uganda's famous Equator Markers.

WHAT TO PACK

FOR TRACKING:

A small, lightweight day backpack
Light, waterproof hiking boots or shoes
Walking socks
Waterproof trousers/pants
Waterproof jacket or poncho, with hood (or waterproof hat)
Lightweight, quick-dry hiking trousers
Short-sleeved shirt or T-shirt
Water bottle or canteen (boiled water and a packed lunch will be provided by your camp)
A camera or video-camera with high-speed settings (or 800ASA speed film minimum—no flash photography is allowed when tracking)

GENERAL:

Long-sleeved shirts and trousers
Short-sleeved shirts, T-shirts and shorts
A down / fleece vest or safari jacket
Travel alarm clock
A sweatshirt or sweater for chilly evenings and early mornings
Sunscreen & after-sun care
Insect repellent (tropical formula recommended)
